  Most areas of Research and Development
- CIP Competitiveness & Innovation Programme Encouraging implementation of technical solutions in specific areas
- Structural Funds




Organised locally; can include improving capacity for industry, education, health, etc.

# **Problems in Accessing EC Funding**

### • Complexity

- Which programme to apply for
- How to write an effective application (proposal)
- Requirements for financial reporting
- Competition
  - Stiff competition ~ 20% success rate
- Continuity of existing consortia
  - The same key organisations are successful
  - It is difficult to break into the club of such organisations



### **Support to overcome problems**

Complexity	Matching idea to an appropriate Work Programme / Call for Proposals
Competition	Writing a clear proposal which explains your idea, it strengths and its relevance
	to the Call
Consortia	Help in identifying key partners to produce a strong and balanced consortium
	Consultancy Training Partnership

Proposal Development

Support available



Explore strengths/weaknesses

Planning and identification of suitable Call

Help in identifying key partners

Help in developing a strong, clear, convincing proposal

Support in managing and reporting on ongoing project

# **Sources of information / support**

- Provision of information
  - EC web-sites and information days
  - National contact points for each area
- More specific help
  - Ad hoc consultancy talk your initial idea through
  - Training courses in developing a proposal, etc
  - Comments and advice on draft proposal
  - Partnership in on-going project management
- Who can help?
  - Colleagues with experience in your organisation
  - Experts with experience outside your organisation



# **Training Courses**

**Example:** "Enhancing Success in European-funded Research Proposals" (Europlan training course for Bulgarian Academy of Science and Sofia University)

#### **Content:**

Preparation Identifying a call Building a consortium Developing a workplan Writing a clear proposal Avoiding ambiguity in English The evaluator's perspective Ongoing management

#### The trainers:

Previous work in EC Experience in evaluation

Experience in project management





#### Training course options:

Duration: e.g. 3, 2, or 1-day courses Standard or customized for participants Hands-on exercises, or simpler lecture style For single group, or open to all



# **Training Options**

- Basic lecture style presenting standard principles
- Flexible course adjusted to specific needs of an organisation (e.g. the degree of background knowledge assumed)
- Course duration (brief overview, 1, 2, 3-days, etc.)
- Smaller groups to facilitate questions
- Extent of individual, pair or group exercises
- Pre-course preparation
